As we approach our fiftieth year preparing mature men for priest-hood, we will celebrate another milestone in the history of our unique Seminary.

September 21, 2011, is the 30th Anniversary of the Annual Lawn Party. Over the years, the proceeds from the Lawn Party, our largest fundraising event, have helped us to provide priestly formation for almost 600 alumni, including Father Daniel Crowley, '68, of the Archdiocese of Boston.

Fr. Crowley is a member of our first graduating class and has attended each of the Annual Lawn Party celebrations. He shares his thoughts on this important milestone here

"The community of men at Blessed John XXIII continues to amaze me. It has been a pleasure to support their formation journeys. They come from all walks of life - doctors, lawyers, teachers, salesmen, pilots - and they left their secular careers to answer God's call, as I did in 1964 at thirty years of age.

I am grateful to have served the faithful of the Archdiocese of Boston for forty-three years. In addition to my parish assignments, I was the Chaplain at Norwood

Hospital and South Shore Hospital for over twenty years. During my time in hospital ministry, I made more than 100,000 pastoral visits to patients.

If it were not for the unique formation program at Blessed John XXIII, I would not have become a priest.

I have attended the Lawn Party since its inception in 1982. More than half of all the seminarians enrolled at Blessed John XXIII


have been introduced to their supporters under the tent at the Lawn Party. What a wonderful tradition!




Ronald W. Cattany, a member of the Class of 2013 at Blessed John XXIII, spoke at a recent Lawn Party. This is an excerpt from his speech.

"About five years ago, I asked the Lord what He wanted me to do with my life. 

Fifth Seminary **Rector** is Appointed to Position in Rome



Msgr. Cornelius M. McRae Blessed John XXIII Rector 1986-1995

Monsignor Cornelius M. McRae, was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Boston in 1961. Among his many assignments, he served as the fifth Rector of our Seminary.

Msgr. McRae has recently been appointed to the position of Spiritual Director of the Casa Santa Maria the Roman home for American priests pursuing graduate studies in that city. This is the second assignment in Rome for Msgr. McRae who served as Spiritual Director at the Seminary's main campus from 1995-2000.

Previous to this new assignment, Msgr. McRae was the Pastor of Saint Catherine of Siena Parish in Norwood for over eleven years.
