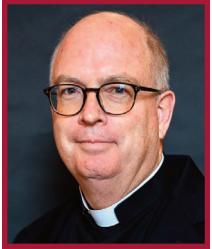

Rev. Msgr. Robert Oliver, BH



“The Priest as Public Person: Challenges and Opportunities in Turbulent Times”

Msgr. Robert Oliver was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Boston in 2000 and this past August joined the full-time faculty at Pope St. John XXIII National Seminary. Msgr. Oliver has over twenty years of experience in conducting canonical penal processes and in safeguarding minors and vulnerable persons from abuse, including service as the Secretary for the Pontifical Commission for the Protection of Minors, Promoter of Justice for the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, and Special Assistant to Vicar General/Moderator of the Curia in the Archdiocese of Boston. His teaching experience includes systematic theology and canon law at St. John’s Seminary in Brighton and canon law at the Catholic University of America. Education: Dartmouth College, A.B., History (1982); Pontifical Gregorian University, S.T.D., Ecclesiology (1997); and Catholic University of America, J.C.D. (2002).
