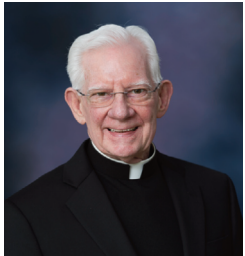

**Rev. Msgr. William P. Fay, Ph.D.** - Msgr. Bill Fay, a priest of the Archdiocese of Boston, is a native of Boston, Massachusetts. Ordained to the priesthood in 1974, he has ministered in a variety of parish assignments as parochial vicar and as pastor. He has also served as a professor of philosophy and Dean of the College of Liberal Arts at St.

John Seminary in Brighton, Massachusetts; General Secretary of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops in Washington, DC; Director of Campus Ministry, Director of Formation for the Permanent Diaconate, and Director of the Propagation of Faith and the Pontifical Mission Societies in the Archdiocese of Boston. Currently he serves as a member of the formation faculty and as a professor of philosophy and theology at Pope St. John XXIII National Seminary.
